*A travel day is a day on which you travel BEFORE or AFTER the actual start/end of your stay.

. E.g. your studies/internship start on 01.09. and you travel to your destination by train on 31.08. - this means you take 1 day of travelling.

If required, you can apply for funding for additional travel days.

For non-environmentally friendly travel (car, motorbike, motorbike, plane etc.), a maximum of two travel days can be funded (1 day for the outward journey and 1 day for the return journey).

If you travel at least 51% of your journey (outward AND return journey) by a sustainable means of transport (bicycle, train, bus, car sharing), you can apply for funding for up to 6 additional days of travel for 'green (environmentally friendly) travel' (maximum 3 days for the outward journey and 3 days for the return journey).

A day of travel is defined as a day on which you travel BEFORE or AFTER the actual start/end of the program abroad. E.g. your studies/internship start on 01.09. and you travel to your destination on 31.08. - this means you take 1 day of travelling.

BUT if, for example, your last exam takes place on 31 July and you are travelling back on the same day, this this day does NOT count as a travel day.

The number of travelling days actually required is stated in the declaration of honour by the student.

The travelling days count as additional days of stay and are funded at the applicable day rate.
