

Exam registration winter semester 2022/23

In order to take part in an exam, please register via the QIS server.

The login information for QIS were handed out to you with the other documents during enrollment.

The registration period for the exams in the **1st examination period** of the winter semester 2022/23 in January/ February **starts on December 19th, 2022 and ends on January 12th, 2023**. By this date you **MUST** have registered for all exams of the 1st examination period in which you wish to participate. In addition, 12.01.2023 is also the last opportunity to withdraw from an exam.

For the **2nd examination period**, the registration period also **begins on December 19th, 2022 and ends on March 12th, 2023**. Also, the last possibility to withdraw from examinations in the 2nd examination period is on 12.03.2023.

The „Covid rule“ which stated that students can withdraw by email up to 5 days before the respective exam has been dropped as of April 1st, 2022.

You will always lose an attempt for exam performances that are not passed or if the exam is not taken.

The „Corona special regulation“ which stated that examination performances which lead to a final failure according to the relevant examination regulations (i.e. 4 four failed attempts) can be repeated once is also out of force since April 1st, 2022.
i.e., if you fail an examination on the 4th attempt, you will be exmatriculated.

If there are technical problems with the registration (certificate etc.), please contact the user advisory service in the library as soon as possible.
