The part-time bachelor's degree program "Digital Management Solutions" will start at the BildungsCampus Herford, Germany, in Winter Semester 2022/23 with financial support from the district of Herford. You are responsible for the conception, management and implementation of interdisciplinary courses in Bachelor's and Master's programs (German and English) and for advanced training courses, particularly in fields of applied project management, business model development and validation as well as of economic fundamentals.

You are actively involved in strengthening this position through research activities, the acquisition of external funds and the establishment of a working group in your area of research. You cooperate with the regional and national industry.

In research and teaching, you work closely with the Institute for Scientific Dialogue of OWL University of Applied Sciences and Arts and build a bridge to the study program „Digital Management Solutions“ as well as to the Herford location. In this context, you get involved in current and future funding projects of the institute.

In particular, this can include interdisciplinary student projects that involve, if possible, several departments. If necessary, you provide 25 % of your teaching as digital teaching in order to enable cross-location courses.
